SKATING POND

Have you ever driven by the Community Centre and wondered what that Red or Green Flag is on the Community Centre sign. It's there to tell you the conditions at the Woodville Skating Pond which is located behind the Fire Hall.



Red means poor conditions and please stay off the ice.

Green means GO! Conditions are good and enjoy.

There are also flags on the light pole at the skating pond.

Skaters have had lots of ice time this year at the skating pond. This is partly the weather but a big thank you goes out to Thane Cook who has been doing a great job keeping an eye on the ice conditions. Thane has also cut a path from the parking area behind the Fire Hall to the ice.

Please Remember:

- Skate at your own risk
- Wear helmets
- Remove the nets and benches when you leave
- Turn off the light

Please do not park in the Twin Mountain parking lot. We are working to cut a path between the pond and the area behind the fire hall for parking access.
